APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP - INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

General Instructions for Applicants: Check List:

1. To qualify, members of Job's Daughters shall make application on Form 79VA and submit same to the Chairman of the Committee on Scholarship Awards.
2. The Application must be completed and signed. Along with the Application must be a personal letter stating the reason for application for the Scholarship and include full name, Bethel number, home address and telephone number.
3. The Chairman of the Committee on Scholarship Awards, upon receipt of the completed application and the personal letter, will establish a confidential file for the application and add all necessary information as it is received.
4. All documents must be postmarked no later than April 30. None will be accepted for consideration after the deadline.
5. (a) Send one (1) official transcript that is most recent and shows the Grade Point Average for the past four years, courses completed, standing in graduating class, and college board examination scores.

(b) Any special honors earned or list of school activities will be helpful.
6. Junior College and Four Year College Students:
Send one (1) official transcript from your High School (four years).
Send one (1) official transcript from your College that shows the Grade Point Average for all work attempted/completed through the last full quarter or semester attended.
7. Send (1) letter from a School Official. Acceptable references are one of the following: High School Principal, Assistant High School Principal, Guidance Director, Guidance Counselor, Dean of College, Associate Dean of School/College. (Letter must be from current year).
8. Statement signed by a majority (3) Executive members of the Bethel Guardian Council certifying that the applicant is a member in good standing and giving a brief summary of the applicant's participation in Job's Daughters activities.
9. Letters of recommendation from three persons (not relatives) who know applicant well.

General Information for Applicants:

Funds for an annual \$500.00 scholarship award have been provided by the Grand Guardian Council of Virginia for Job's Daughter students of outstanding ability and sincerity of purpose. The award shall be paid directly to the school of the recipient's choice. The number of scholarships awarded annually will be determined by the amount of funds on hand, by the amount received from funds earned from the Miss Job's Daughter Pageant, interest earned from the Scholarship, Educational and Promotional funds and from donations and bequests.

High School graduates, Junior College, and Four Year College and University students who are Job's Daughters in good standing may apply, provided they are unmarried, and under twenty-six (26) years of age. Scholarships shall be awarded for professional, vocational and academic purposes.

The award shall be judged on the following:

1. Scholastic Achievements
2. Participation in Job's Daughters Activities

The Committee on Scholarship Awards shall consist of three members appointed by the Grand Guardian in accordance with the Manual of Rules and Regulations of the Grand Guardian Council of Virginia. This Committee shall be entrusted with the responsibility of considering applications and making the awards at each Annual Session of the Grand Guardian Council.

Confidential information concerning applicants for Scholarships shall not be disclosed to anyone other than the committee.

Confidential applications shall be destroyed at the close of each Grand Guardian Council year.

Applications and all the required information for Scholarship Awards shall be postmarked no later than April 30 of the current year. No applications will be accepted after the postmark date of April 30.
