

Leadership Weekend 2008

Leadership Weekend 2008 will be held at CrossRoads Camp, Lowesville, Virginia on May 2-4, 2008. The weekend was established to give Daughters the opportunity to learn leadership skills they can use in the Bethel and in their personal endeavors. During the course of the weekend, the Daughters will participate in activities and discussions designed to enhance their self-esteem and leadership skills.

Attendee Selection Process

Each Bethel will select two (2) Daughters to attend Leadership Weekend. While the method of selection is left up to the individual Bethel Guardian Councils, the committee asks that the Bethel Guardian Council consider Daughters who are at least 12 years of age who demonstrate Job's Daughter leadership characteristics and Daughters who have NOT attended Leadership Weekend in previous years. We would like as many Daughters as possible to experience Leadership Weekend. As an added membership incentive, Daughters who have signed at least two (2) petitions this Grand Guardian Council Year, may also attend Leadership.

Forms

All participants must complete the registration and medical forms and submit them by the March 31, 2008 deadline. All forms will be mailed to the Bethel Guardian and will be posted on the VA Job's Daughter Website. Once the registration and medical forms are received, information packets will be mailed directly to each Daughter attending Leadership Weekend.

Cost

The entire weekend is funded by the generous donations from our Masonic Family (Masonic Lodges, Eastern Star Chapters and Amaranth Courts). There is no cost to the Bethel or Daughters. Each Bethel is responsible for transportation to and from the camp.
