It's hard to believe, but it's almost Pageant time again and enclosed is the information on the 41st Annual Miss Virginia Job's Daughter Pageant which will be held in Williamsburg November 23-24th at Crowne Plaza Williamsburg at Fort Magruder.

Each Bethel is asked to select a Candidate and Alternate to represent their Bethel at the Pageant. To be eligible for selection a daughter must:

1. Have been a member of the Bethel for at least six (6) months
2. Have regular attendance at Bethel meetings (regular attendance means no unexcused absences as outlined by the Bethel Guardian Council)
3. Have passed the Proficiency work
4. Past Honored Queens and previous contestants meeting all other requirements shall have equal consideration
5. All candidates, alternates and chaperons **must stay at the Pageant Headquarters – The Crowne Plaza at Fort Magruder, both Friday and Saturday nights.**

The cost of for the entire weekend will be \$175.00 and it includes hotel rooms for the Candidate, Alternate and Chaperone for Friday and Saturday night, Friday night dinner, Saturday breakfast, snacks, Saturday lunch and admission to the pageant.

The Pageant Committee is planning a fun-filled weekend and hopes that your Bethel will send two (2) representatives to the Pageant and then come and support your Candidate and Alternate on Saturday night.

Each year awards are given to the daughter and Bethel who sell the most ads for the Pageant book and this year is no exception. You don't have to be the Candidate or Alternate to sell ads, anyone can sell them and we encourage you to sell them. If you sell the most ads you will be recognized on stage during pageant and presented with a great gift.
